Malaria is a serious and sometimes fatal disease caused by a Plasmodium parasite that commonly infects a certain type of mosquito

(female Anopheles) which feeds on humans. People who get malaria are typically very sick with high fevers, shaking chills, and flu-like illness.

In 1880 Dr. Alphonse Laveran discovered the Malaria parasite

Malaria occurs in more than 100 countries and territories. About half of the world's population is at risk. Large areas of Africa and South Asia and parts of Central and South America, the Caribbean, Southeast Asia, the Middle East, and Oceania are considered areas where malaria transmission occurs.

In 1820 OUININE was extracted from the Cinchona tree bark and named by PIERRE JOSEPH PELLETIER and JOSEPH CAVENTOU. QUININE is a Antimalarial Drug.




EMPIRE 40-
