CHRISTIAAN NEETHLING BARNARD

(1922 - 2001)

was a South African cardiac surgeon who **performed** the world's first human-to-human heart transplant operation.

On 3 December 1967, Barnard transplanted the heart of accident victim Denise Darvall into the chest of 54-year-old Louis Washkansky, who regained full consciousness and was able to talk easily with his wife, before dying 18 days later of pneumonia, largely brought on by the antirejection drugs that suppressed his immune system.
