




Early and later use



Security watermarks used on stamps

Single: each stamp has a single design



o Multiple: a single design repeated all over the sheet



Large sheet or All-over: a single design or pattern applied once or twice on a sheet of paper. The complete design will encompass multiple stamps, but many stamps in the sheet will have no watermark.






